# **Call to Order**

# Legislative Overview

Mr. Dee Larsen gave an overview of the 2021 legislative session. Post-retirement reemployment is again a topic of interest. H.B. 150 Public Safety Post-retirement Reemployment Amendments was discussed. URS is working with the bill sponsor to provide information and education.

# Salt Lake City Premium Refund

Mr. Rob Dolphin reviewed the request by Salt Lake City for a PEHP Premium Refund of \$2,400,000. Salt Lake City Medical program has experienced favorable claim experience for the calendar year 2020. The program has a target day in reserve of 55-100 days. At November 30, 2020, the unaudited days in reserve was 179. The \$2,400,000 refund will reduce the days in reserve to 154.

**ACTION:** Mr. Roger Donohoe moved, seconded by Mr. Richard Ellis, to approve the Salt Lake City PEHP premium refund of \$2,400,000. The motion passed unanimously, 5-0.
