

HB 23 First Responder Mental Health Services



Mental health resources include:

- An assessment to determine treatment
- Outpatient treatment by a therapist
- Peer support services

Must be given to:

- All first responders
- Spouse and <u>children</u> of first responders
- Surviving spouses of first responders who died in the line-of-duty
- <u>Retired first responders</u>

Integrating into Different Programs



Enroll in Regular Employee Assistance Counseling

Should be easy to do

Secure Peer Support Services

- May be available through EAP
- Joint Contract with Other Agencies

Outpatient Treatment Options

- Pay for Cost Sharing of Existing Health Plan
- Pay from Agency Budget
- Enroll on Health Plan for Mental Health Only

\$5M Grant Program

HB 289 Coverage for EMS Personnel



State-paid Insurance Coverage for Rural EMS Volunteers

- Funding for 259 Volunteers
- Family members paid at 75%
- No other coverage government or employer available
- Respond to at least 20% of calls

SB 19 Pilot for Infertility Coverage



\$4,000 Infertility Benefit Per Implant

- Pilot for the State Health Insurance Plan
- Health Plans Already Pay for ART Births
- Complications from Multi-Embryo Implants
- Condition \$4,000 Payment on <u>Single-Embryo Implant</u>
- Standard PEHP Benefit

Understanding Rebates

- Full Retail Rate Paid at Pharmacy
- Drug Manufacturers Give Post-Sale Rebates
- Rebates can be Significant
- Flow from Manufacturer, to PBM, to Plan, to Group

Problems with the System

- Incentive for High-Rebate Drugs Regardless of Costs
- <u>Temptation for Skimming off Rebate</u>

Your Best Defense



Ask Questions

(1) Do we get the full value of rebates?(2) What is the PMPM costs for RX?

PMPM = Per Member Per Month

If You Can't Beat Copay Assistance, Maximize It

Traditional Copay	\$5,000	\$4,775	\$225	\$220	\$5
Targeted Coinsurance	\$5 <i>,</i> 000	\$3,500	\$1,500	\$1,495	\$5

SB 139 Prescription Cost Amendments **PEHP** Health & Benefits

\$2.2M Total for the State Health Plan

- \$382,000 in Lost Member Cost Sharing
- \$58,000 in Additional Medical Services
- \$1.8M in Lost Copay Assistance/Revenue for Drug Companies
- Only Looking at about 400 people on Specialty Drugs

Bill Did Not Pass

- Pharmacy is complex
- Cost Savings Strategies are Important

HB 358 Mental Health Parity



Should Governments be Able to Opt Out of Federal Law?

- Mistake to Voluntarily Accept Compliance Risk
- Hard to Make Exactly Equivalent

Agreed Upon Approach for HB 358

- Substantial Compliance in Good Faith under State Law
- Tied Residential Treatment to Step-down Nursing Home Care

Bill Did Not Pass

- Coverage, including Residential Treatment, is Important
- Residential Treatment Poses Unique Challenges

Gender Dysphoria Coverage



Gender Dysphoria

- Don't Identify with Birth Gender
- Considered a Mental Health Condition
- Qualifies for Medical Coverage

Coverage

- Many Health Plans Cover Therapy & Drugs
- Many Exclude Gender Reassignment Surgery

Legal Question under Title VII

- Some Cases Say Illegal to Exclude
 <u>Ultimately a Question of Risk for Employers</u>

No Surprises Act



Very, Very Big Deal

- Don't Need to Worry About Finding an In-Network Hospital When Experiencing an Emergency
- Don't Need to Worry About Getting Gouged by Air Ambulance
- Still Too Early to Say How the Backend is Going.




