

HB 254, HEALTH CARE AMENDMENTS, (Ward, R)

Anticipated Fiscal Impact:

No Anticipated Costs to the State Health Insurance Risk Pool

HB 254 removes the requirement that a minor's parents be notified prior to the minor being provided contraceptives. HB 254 should not have a material impact on the State Health Insurance Risk Pool because any claim for a contraceptive made against the health plan would provide parental notice, which would lead to the same dispensing outcome for contraceptives as currently exists. Accordingly, a minor who wanted to receive contraceptives without parental consent would need to acquire them outside of the health plan.
