

SB 249: Anticipated Fiscal Impact for State: Public Employees' Health Program Amendments (Sen. Weiler, T.)

No Fiscal Impact

Summary

SB 249 would require PEHP to contract with any entity that provides autism-related services in rural counties at commercially reasonable rates. We believe PEHP's current rates are commercially reasonable and that because it generally operates open provider networks, including more autism providers would not increase the volume of services provided. As such, we don't anticipate any fiscal impact to the state employee health plan.
