

HB 269 AMBULANCE PROVIDER PAYMENT AMENDMENTS
(Maloy, A. Cory)

Anticipated Fiscal Impact: none

Currently, ambulance providers bill for the specific medications used during a transport. The average amount billed represents 1.8% of the ambulance base rate. To simplify the billing process, HB 269 discontinues the ability of ambulance services to bill for medications separately and, in its place, adds a 1.8% into the base rate to cover the cost of medications. Because 1.8% represents the average amount currently spent on medications, there is no additional cost to the state.
